Since last year, Hamilton CMA's unemployment rate has been consistently lower than Canada's and Ontario's.

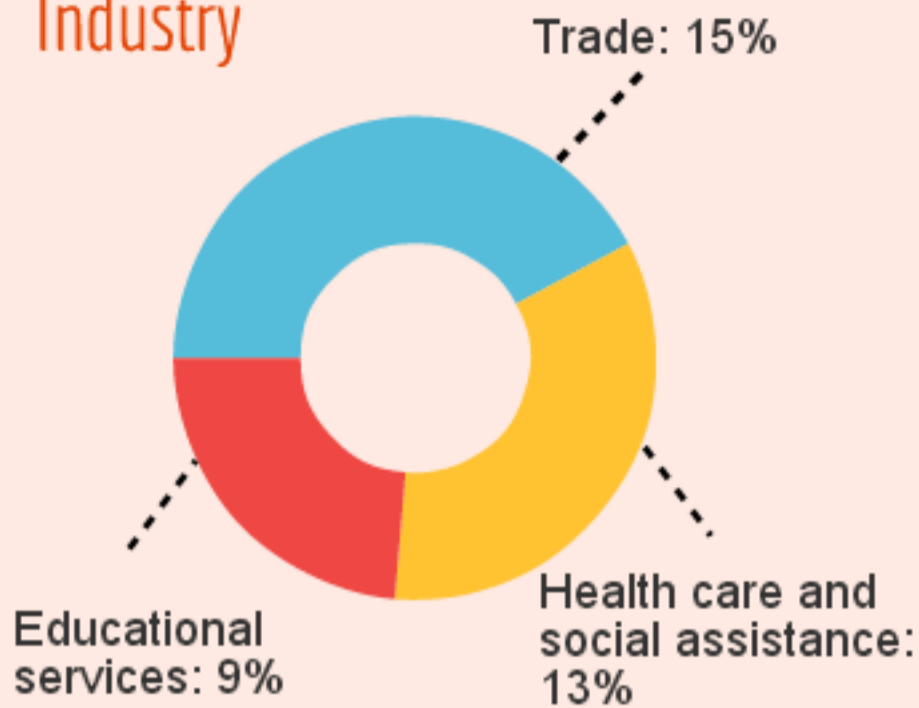
Unemployment Rate

Top Industries, Share of Workforce

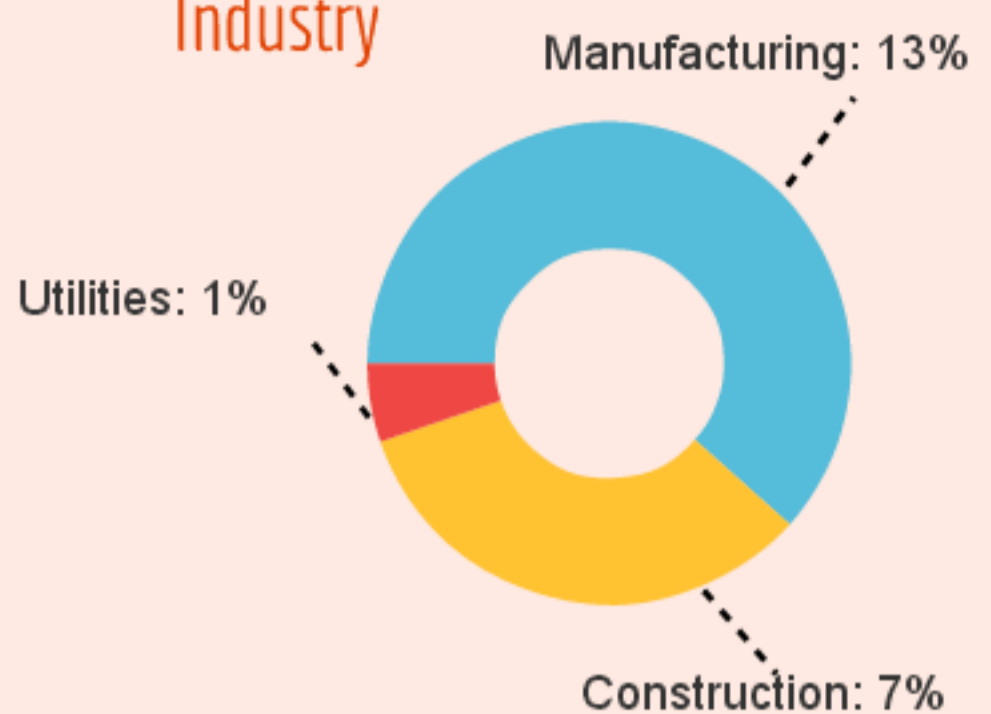
Service Producing Sector
